



Job Title: Community Worker - Canada Summer Jobs

Job Summary: We are seeking two Community Workers to support the delivery of the Multicultural and Diversity Project activities for an eight-week period, working 35 hours a week. The successful candidates will be responsible for assisting with the organization of the multicultural festival, supporting the Communications Director with communications, and engaging with youth in the community. This position is funded under the Canada Summer Jobs program and requires the candidate to be between the ages of 15 and 30 at the start of employment and legally entitled to work in Canada.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in the planning, organization, and execution of the Multicultural Festival, including coordinating vendors, performers, and volunteers
- Help to create and distribute marketing and communications materials for the festival
- Assist the Communications Director with social media management, content creation, and partnership development
- Support the engagement of youth in the community through activities and events
- Assist in the delivery of workshops and presentations related to multiculturalism and diversity
- Provide administrative support for the Multicultural and Diversity Project, including maintaining records and preparing reports
- Help to set up and dismantle festival equipment, booths, and stages

Qualifications:

- Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been confirmed under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and legally entitled to work in Canada
- Must be between the ages of 15 and 30 at the start of employment
- Strong organizational and project management skills
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Experience in event planning and coordination is an asset
- Knowledge of social media platforms and trends
- Experience working with youth and/or in a multicultural setting is an asset
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team



- Knowledge of relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations is an asset
